



Information sheet about the Stipendium Hungaricum program for KNU students

The program allows up to 3000 international students to start their studies in Hungary this year (2016) without tuition fee and with a scholarship. Be one of them at the Budapest University of Technology and Economics (BME), Hungary, EU.

Provisions covered by the scholarship

1. Exemption from the payment of tuition fee (valid for BME as well).
2. Monthly stipend: non-degree, bachelor, master and one-tier master level: monthly HUF 40 460 (cca EUR 130) contribution to the living expenses, for 12 months a year, until the completion of study period.
3. PhD level: currently monthly HUF 100 000 (cca EUR 325) at present – for 12 months a year, until the completion of studies –the amount is expected to be raised from September 2016.
4. Accommodation: dormitory place or a monthly contribution of HUF 30 000 to accommodation costs for the whole duration of the scholarship period.
5. Medical insurance: health care services according to the relevant Hungarian legislation (Act No. 80 of 1997, national health insurance card) and supplementary medical insurance.

BME specific information for KNU students

- Language of instruction: English for international students (other: Hungarian, German, French)
- Accreditation: full, all programs
- Credit system: full compliance with ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System)
- Number of engineering courses available in English (each semester): approx. 300
- Level of studies: BSc, MSc, PhD
- Field of studies: Electrical Engineering and Informatics, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Architecture, Chemical Technology and Biotechnology, Transportation Engineering and Vehicle Engineering, Natural Sciences, Economic and Social Sciences
- Majors available for one semester or two semester long study abroad (non degree seeking): all
- Majors available for **double degrees with KNU**: electrical engineering and engineering information technology (software engineering) – currently at BSc level, minimal length of study at BME: 1 year
- English language on-line study management system is available, English language transcript is provided at the end of studies.
- English proficiency requirement: TOEFL iBT score of 90, or PBT score of 550, or Cambridge First Certificate "B", or IELTS score of 5.0, or contact BME admission office: admission@kth.bme.hu
